10. pivot joints They let bones turn and twist.
11. ball and socket joints They allow one bone to be moved in a circle while another stays still.

13. fixed joints They hold bones in place with no movement, they are found in the skull.
14. tendons They are long, thin bands that tie muscles to bones.
