1. scrambled Past tense scramble. To climb or advance over something using hands and feet.
2. sorted Organized, arranged.
3. ragged Torn or worn to rags; tattered.
4. darted Past tense dart. To move suddenly or rapidly.
5. hissed Past tense hiss. To make a sharp sibilant sound as of the letter s, often as a sign of disapproval or derision.
6. slithered Past tense slither. To move smoothly over a surface with a twisting or oscillating motion.
7. butte An isolated hill with steep sides and a flat top.
8. tool A device or implement, typically hand-held, used to carry out a particular function.
9. scribble To write or draw carelessly or hurriedly.
10. research The systematic investigation into a subject in order to establish facts and reach new conclusions.
11. beanstalk The stem of a bean plant.
12. mean To intend or be intended to express a particular idea in speech or writing.
13. harvest The season during which crops ripen and are gathered.
14. tease Playfully make fun of or attempt to provoke.
15. ashamed Feeling embarrassed; feeling full of shame.
16. advice Guidance or recommendations offered with regard to future action.
17. patch A piece of material used to cover a torn or weak point.
18. flock A number of birds moving or resting together.
19. dared Past tense dare. To have the courage to do something.
20. begged Past tense beg. To ask someone earnestly or humbly for something such as a favor.
21. sketch A rough or unfinished drawing or painting.

22. dummy A model or replica of a human being.
23. pot A rounded or cylindrical container used for storage or cooking.
24. nap A short sleep, especially during the day.
25. agreed Past tense agree. To have the same opinion.
26. dig To break up and move earth with a tool or with hands, paws, etc.
27. buried Past tense bury. To put or hide underground.
28. embarrassed Past tense embarrass. To cause to feel awkward, self-conscious, or ashamed.
29. straighten To make or become straight.
30. weed A wild plant growing where it is not wanted and in competition with cultivated plants.
31. blacksmith A person who makes and repairs things in iron by hand.
32. squash To crush or squeeze (something) so that it becomes flat, soft, or out of shape.
33. weary Tired.
34. pecan tree Tall hickory tree, grown for its smooth pinkish-brown nut resembling a walnut.
35. shrugged Past tense shrug. To raise one's shoulders slightly and momentarily to express doubt, ignorance, or indifference.
36. sneaked Past tense sneak. To move, go, or convey in a furtive or stealthy manner.
37. lid A removable or hinged cover for the top of a container.
38. rickety Poorly made and likely to collapse.
39. blur To make or become unclear or less distinct.
40. blasted Past tense blast. To strike something with great force (informal).
41. jerky Characterized by abrupt stops and starts.
42. hum To make a low, steady continuous sound like that of a bee.
43. noodle A very thin, long strip of pasta or a similar flour paste.
44. canvas A strong, coarse unbleached cloth used to make sails, tents, furnishings, etc.
45. propped up Past tense prop up. To give support or help to somebody or something.

46. clack To make or cause to make a sharp sound as of a hard object striking another.
47. clasping Clasp, clasped, clasping. To grasp tightly with one's hand.
48. gathered Past tense gather. To come or bring together; assemble or accumulate.
49. staring Stare, stared, staring. To look fixedly at someone or something with the eyes wide open.
50. sprout To produce shoots.
51. shushed Past tense shush. To order to be silent; hush.
52. startled Past tense startle. To cause to feel sudden shock or alarm.
53. bow A knot tied with two loops and two loose ends.
54. struggled Past tense struggle. To make forceful efforts to get free.
55. roar A full, deep, prolonged sound as made by a lion, natural force, or engine.
56. clerk A person employed in an office or bank to keep records or accounts and to other routine administrative duties.
57. features A distinctive attribute or aspect.
58. disappointed Sad or displeased because one's hopes or expectations have not been fulfilled.
59. drawer A lidless box-like storage compartment that may be slid horizontally in and out of a desk or chest.
60. manga A Japanese style of cartoons, comic books, and animated films, typically with a science fiction and very violent.

FOCUS ON SCIENCE

1. nest It is used as a home for baby birds.
2. larva The part of an insect's life cycle between the egg and the pupa.
3. caterpillar A butterfly larva.
4. pupa The third part of an insect's life-cycle. In this part, the larva or caterpillar, makes a hard covering.
5. tadpole The larva of frogs and toads living in water.
6. mammal An animal whose life cycle includes a part when he nurses on his mother's milk.
7. amphibian Any cold-blooded animal, including frogs, that has gills and lungs.
8. nursling A nursing infant or young animal.
9. reptile Any cold-blooded vertebrate with dry, scaly skin.
